<sup>1</sup>University Breadth requirements must total 12-credits (3-credits from each group). Each group must represent a different subject area and may not be cross-listed. No courses used for University Breadth may be from the student's major department. A lab course is not required to satisfy the University Group D requirement. A grade of C- or better is required for all University Breadth courses.

<sup>2</sup>If two course in a group (A, B, C or D) have been taken in the same department or program, a third course cross-listed with that program will not satisfy the distribution requirement of "at least two programs". Up to 3-credits from each of the University Breadth Requirement categories may be used to simultaneously satisfy the College of Arts & Sciences Breadth Requirement. The minimum grade for all College of Arts & Sciences Breadth courses is C-.

<sup>3</sup>HIST 268 should be taken during sophomore year and must be taken **BEFORE** HIST 400.

<sup>4</sup>One course must be from pre-1700 History (excluding HIST 101, 103 & 105) **AND** one course must be from Asian, African, and Latin American or Middle Eastern History (excluding HIST 268).
